1st Qtr:

1) Starting the 3rd Qtr of 2023 the section "Mission Pledges" will be eliminated, and all recipient organizations will be listed under "Discretionary Programs," receiving quarterly disbursements. The Mission Pledge recipents will be notified of the change, but will continue receiving their 2nd Qtr monthly disbursements through June.

2nd Qtr:

- 1) In reference to Note #1 in the 1st Qtr., the Mission Pledges received their 2nd Qtr. monthly disbursements as planned in April, May, and June, and beginning with the 3rd Qtr. will receive their disbursements on a quarterly basis at the end of each quarter as were notified. They will then be treated like all of the other organizations under Discretionary Programs without a fixed amount.
- 2) In the interest of refocusing limited benevolence dollars for the greatest impact, beginning in Qtr. 2 the Benevolence Committee decided to replace Voice of the Martyrs with Lutheran's for Life as a recipient organization, along with reinstating Lutheran Asian Ministries.
- 3) The Benevolence Committee's 3rd Qtr meeting in October will involve further discussion of continued refocusing of Charity's benevolence dollars for greater impact.

3rd Qtr:

- 1) In the interest of continued refocusing of Charity's benevolence dollars, final 3rd Quarter disbursements were made to: 1) Freedom Fellowship, and 2) Adventures in Missions, along with notifications that Charity will no longer be supporting them.
